Programme Details:

On 12.1.2025 invited by Ramakrishna Mission at Swamiji Vivekanada's ancestral home, the students of Rammohan College participated in a 5 kilometre stretch procession to observe National Youth Day.

The NSS unit of Rammohan College observed the National Youth Day on 16.1.2025 in the college premises. The principal of our college lit an earthen lamp to inaugurate the programme at Room Number 306 of the New Science Building. It was followed by an opening song by NSS volunteer, Subhomita"*TomareikoriyachhiJibonerdhrubotara*" (I have made you my guiding star) a Rabindrasangeet frequently sung by Swami Vivekananda. Our Principal Prof. (Dr.) Saswati Sanyal urged the students to read and interpret Swami Vivekananda in their own way. She touched on the greatness of Swami Vivekananda as a person and a philosopher.Prof. (Dr) Kabita Dey spoke on Swami Vivekananda's teachings and their relevance to the motto and principles of National Service Scheme. In her speech, she explained how the love for the motherland, the love towards his fellow countrymen as possessed by Swami Vivekananda continue to inspire the youth.Prof. (Dr.) Debjanee Ganguly, in her short speech, explained the relevance of Swami Vivekananda's teachings. She insisted on practice of discipline and meditation to follow the youth icon towards building good human values. The duration of indoor programme was1 hour and 30 minutes. The whole programme was very inspiring for the 64 students and 14 faculties who attended. The attendees were served simple snacks and juice as refreshment. The session was followed by activity of distribution of food items and old clothes to the pavement dwellers of Rammohan Sarani. The NSS volunteers and faculty participated in this service to the underprivileged. The students and faculty came up with fresh suggestions to serve the underprivileged community in our future programmes after the activity.
