- c. All commercial terms applicable for this training centre will be decided and finally implemented by the GSCE and **Rammahan College** Management, if required.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The parties are responsible for their individual acts of commission and / or omission, due to their negligence - and non-compliance of statutory liabilities and obligations.
2. The engagement is on a principal-to-principal basis and no party shall hold each other as agent and or principal of the other for any liability.
3. This MOU shall be effective from date of execution and shall be in force for a period of 5 years from the date of execution. It is expressly agreed between the parties that either party shall be entitled to terminate this agreement at any time by giving prior notice of 90 days in writing.
4. This Engagement is not intended nor shall be construed as creating a joint venture, partnership or other form of business association.
